1. Terms & Conditions:

- A) The quotations received after this deadline & unsealed shall not be entertained under any circumstances whatsoever. In case of postal delay this Institute will not be responsible. **The offer Submitted Fax/Email shall not be considered and no correspondence will be entertained in this matter.**
- B) Quotations must be in the enclosed prescribed Performa on the letter head of the firm duly signed by the Proprietor/ Partner/ Director or their authorized representative, in case of signing of quotation by the authorized representative letter of authorization must be attached with the quotation. Quotation may be dropped in “**Tender Box**” located in Administration Block of NIPER, Hajipur **or by post/Courier.**
- C) Rates must be quoted in **Indian rupees** and as per the format specified taxes extra if any must be written separately.
- D) Becoming L1 will not be the criteria for awarding of purchase order unless the rates are reasonable & justified.
- E) RTGS/NEFT details need to be furnished by the supplier with the quotation on the letter head of supplier/firm/agency.
- F) The firm/agency may satisfy the following conditions and attach self-attested copy of the same with the quotation:
 - The firm shall have valid GSTIN and IT PAN.
 - **The firm should not be black listed by any Govt. Agency/Dept.**
- G) Quotations qualified by such vague and indefinite expressions such as “subject to prior confirmation”, “subject to immediate acceptance” etc. will be treated as vague offers and rejected accordingly. Any conditional quotation shall be rejected summarily.
