Following terms and conditions supersede all existing "Buyer added Bid Specific Terms and conditions" given in the bid document or any previous corrigendum. Prospective bidders are advised to bid as per following Terms and Conditions:

Buyer Added Bid Specific Additional Terms and Conditions

1. **OPTION CLAUSE:** The buyer can increase or decrease the contract quantity or contract duration up to 25 percent at the time of issue of the contract. However, once the contract is issued, contract quantity or contract duration can only be increased up to 25 percent. Bidders are bound to accept the revised quantity or duration
2. **Bidder financial standing:** The bidder should not be under liquidation, court receivership or similar proceedings, should not be bankrupt. Bidder to upload undertaking to this effect with bid.
3. **Proof for Past Experience and Project Experience clause:** For fulfilling the experience criteria any one of the following documents may be considered as valid proof for meeting the experience criteria:a. Contract copy along with Invoice(s) with self-certification by the bidder that service/supplies against the invoices have been executed.b. Execution certificate by client with contract value.c. Any other document in support of contract execution like Third Party Inspection release note, etc.**Proof for Past Experience and Project Experience clause:** For fulfilling the experience criteria any one of the following documents may be considered as valid proof for meeting the experience criteria:a. Contract copy along with Invoice(s) with self-certification by the bidder that service/supplies against the invoices have been executed.b. Execution certificate by client with contract value.c. Any other document in support of contract execution like Third Party Inspection release note, etc.

5. Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS

1. The Bidder must have five years experience in providing manpower (Security services, Housekeeping Staff and others) in any Central or State Govt./Semi-Govt./PSU/Autonomous Body/Reputed Corporate Sector Organization.
2. The bidders should not have been indicted for any criminal, fraudulent or corruption activity and not have been blacklisted by any Central or State Govt./Semi-Govt./PSU/Autonomous Body/Reputed Corporate Sector Organization. Undertaking may be submitted by Bidder.
3. The bidders should have employed at least 150 employees in any Central or State Govt./Semi- Govt./PSU/Autonomous Body/Reputed Corporate Sector Organization.
4. The agency/bidder should have undertaken any one of the following works during the immediate past 5 years in any Central or State Govt./Semi- Govt./PSU/Autonomous Body/Reputed Corporate Sector Organization:-
 - One single order not less than 80% of estimated contract amount,
 - Two orders not less than 50% of estimated contract amount,

- Three orders not less than 40% of estimated contract amount.
5. A declaration has to be given that the agency/contractor has not been blacklisted by the Central/State Govt./Autonomous body/Company during the last three years.
6. Self-attested copies of the following documents must be uploaded for technical evaluation:
- Audited Balance Sheet, Audited Income and Expenditure statement, Audited Profit and Loss Account and Income Tax Return of last Three financial years.
 - Registration Certificate of Firm/Agency/Organization as Partnership/ Proprietorship/Private Limited/Limited Company.
 - Copy of Registration with Labour Department of the State/Central Govt. or any other regulations time to time required as per guidelines of Govt., if any.
 - Copy of ESI Registration and latest paid challan.
 - Copy of EPFO Registration and latest paid challan.
 - Copy of Registration under GST/PAN.
 - Copy of Registration under 'The Contract Labour (Regulation & Abolition) Act, 1970'.
 - Copy of Registration No. and PASARA Certificate under (Private Security Agencies Regulation) Act, 2005.

Disclaimer

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization, whereby Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any eccentricity / restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. If any clause(s) is / are incorporated by the Buyer regarding following, the bid and resultant contracts shall be treated as null and void and such bids may be cancelled by GeM at any stage of bidding process without any notice:-

1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issued by DPIIT in this regard.
2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. (However, in bids for [attached categories](#), trials are allowed as per approved procurement policy of the buyer nodal Ministries)
9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without

specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.

10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.
15. Any ATC clause in contravention with GeM GTC Clause 4 (xiii)(h) will be invalid. In case of multiple L1 bidders against a service bid, the buyer shall place the Contract by selection of a bidder amongst the L-1 bidders through a Random Algorithm executed by GeM system.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
